Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the International Marie de France Society Fiftieth International Congress on Medieval Studies Western Michigan University, May 10, 2015

Welcome, Ann McCullough, President—The meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m. by Ed Ouellette. Society President gave the welcoming remarks and then yielded the floor to the Secretary-Treasurer. The minutes from the 2014 meeting were presented and approved.

As this was my first meeting as Secretary-Treasurer I had forgotten to print up the minutes from last year's meeting. I reviewed them from our file copy and they were approved. Minutes *will* be printed for the 2016 meeting.

Secretary-Treasurer's Report

- In the IMFS account, we currently have \$6,076.80.
- Lightning Source is NOT a good fit for printing our journal. Their staff was found to be uncooperative, uncommunicative, and unprofessional. In an effort to get the journal out and keep it to a more timely publication schedule, Ed Ouellette went to a local printer and had 60 copies printed up and mailed. The results were good and working with a local printer appears to be a better option, due to ease of (and improved) communications. The one thing we would like to do better is to have the issues perfect-bound. This is something Ed Ouellette will pursue once he relocates to Oklahoma later this year.
- Expenses were paid to the printer for 60 copies of *Le Cygne*, New Series.
- Expenses were paid to the Post Office for mailing the issues.
- Approximately 7 issues were returned, as their addresses were no longer valid.
- Looking to have issue #2 ready by November, and to the printers in December. Expected mailing date will be just after New Year's, if not before.
- Issues were mailed to those on our current list of members if they were no more than 2 years in arrears.
- Members who were 3 or more years in arrears were dropped from our rolls.
- Members can now pay their dues using PayPal.
